NORMAL VENUE


The Branch meets at the **Public Record Office of Northern** Ireland (PRONI), 2 Titanic Boulevard, BELFAST, BT3 9HQ. <u>Meetings run from 18:30 to 20:45 (except conferences).</u>

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

<u>By bus:</u> From Belfast City centre at Donegall Square West take Metro 26, 26A, 26B or 26C route.

For the **26, 26B and 26C**, alight at the Premier Inn just after passing the Odyssey Arena. The PRONI building is directly across the road.

For the **26A** alight at the Citibank building after passing the Odyssey Arena, then take the next left off Sydenham Road.



This takes you into Titanic Boulevard and PRONI is on the left hand side.

<u>Rail</u>: The Titanic Quarter Station is only a short walk from PRONI, approximately 10 minutes away on foot. If travelling from Belfast, cross the footbridge onto Sydenham Road. Turn left from the footbridge onto the Sydenham Road then take the first turn on the right onto Titanic Boulevard. PRONI is on the left hand side.
