Research for the project is going well - collections of Ballykinlar material have been explored at PRONI, Cavan County Museum, the War Memorial Museum, Belfast, and Kilmainham Gaol. Relatives of WW1 soldiers and internees have also approached the Museum with information and artefacts, and Frank Boyd of Rademon has kindly lent a photograph album of Ballykinlar Camp dating from 1900-1902!
